For selecting your experience, please consider the following criteria:

- The questionnaire must be filled in a comprehensive and understandable way and submitted until November 10th 2017.
- The experience can refer to a method used in the context of a concrete project, to an overall strategy or approach of the organization or to any other practice applied in your or your Partner Organizations' working fields.¹
- The experience must be considered potentially relevant for other organizations in our knowledge network. The most important thing is the possibility to learn from it!
- The experience must fit in one of our main sectors **Rural Development Natural Resource**Management, Human Rights Civil Society or Education.
- Negative experiences & failures can be part of successful project work and teach us a lot!
 Therefore we especially encourage the submission of relevant negative experiences. As it requires a special effort to share negative experiences, we will reward them with special prizes.

We are sure you have many stories worth sharing and experiences others can learn from. This is why we are very much looking forward to receiving your submissions!
