Clemens presents PEL – Knowledge Managament Programme of the DKA in Central America and its linkages to KNOW-HOW3000

- PEL = Programmatisches Element in Central America is a 3-years-project, financed by DKA with € 50.000 and by kfb with € 12.500; Sum is € 62.500 for 3 years for activities of partner organisations of the DKA/kfb in Central America
- Partly directly related to KH3000 activities: selected partner organisations from DKA and kfb are supported to participate in KH3000 activities, if activities are happening in the same country as the partner organisations are working in.
- Additionally it funds "its own" instruments (often indirectly/ thematically related to KH3000 activities):
 - A fund for systematizations, that allow POs to systematize their experiences, e.g. for the regularly organized KH3000 conferences at the end of a 3 years phase
 - o A pool of funds for ideas that emerge spontaneously e.g. pilot projects
 - Topic of Agroecology and exchange meetings for this topic, like a dialogue forum (by FUNDESYRAM)
 - Topic gender: another focus emerged called "masculinities" with a focus on men as a target group; "Self-Esteem" is another topic, especially for women
 - Bringing together POs working with children and youth has not been successful;
 also linking of ecclesiastical POs proved to be difficult
- Success:
 - Exchange between POs from the confinancing framework of H3 and those who are not part of this framework was a success → diversity of partners, networking,...
 - Some directly financed organizations (e.g. FEM, FUNARTE) moved closer to H3 through participation in KH3000 activities, promoting the possibilities of entering the cofinancing framework and their institutional strengthening in general
- What was not achieved?
 - Documentation of the directly financed events is a challenge; it is hard for DKA to understand and reproduce how fruitful the events were for the participants;
 - Too much instruments are available for the POs; maybe focusing on a few would be beneficial
 - The effort for DKA in Austria is high and also programme officers of HORIZONT3000 and Partner Organisations need time resources to support instruments of PEL – time for the coordination of events has never been budgeted as a separate position in PEL, so it was an additional effort for everybody involved
- The budget of PEL grew from 24.000 in the first 3 years to 62.500 in the second 3years-phase from 2016-18; but 20.000 from this phase remains unused, this amount can be transferred to the next phase

Discussion on KNOW-HOW3000 and MO activities in East Africa

- DKA: to support the participation of directly financed partners in KH3000 activities would be better than introducing new elements in EAF;
- BSIN: a similar concept as PEL would be interesting for BSIN, but does not have the capacity for the coordination work (would have to be done by H3)
- WHG: previous experiences with trainings funded by MOs show that it would be

	 better to organise 2 events instead of only 1 for all partners, because partners have different levels and when trainings become too big, learning processes are worse. KK: topics of trainings in the upcoming project phase in EAF will be on M&E and organisational development; also there will be training series on crucial topics, instead of big trainings with a high amount of partners and many different topics. DKA: Emphasis on the resources needed for the organization of trainings – especially in the partner countries and also at DKA itself if there are additional PEL activities. KK: Caroline Ngunga (TA for KM in EAF) is advising the regional office on KM topics and activities; her assignment includes to act as a flying TA on KM within partner organisations; Jennifer remains with the responsibility for the KNOW-HOW3000 project;

Matthias/BSIN would like to have a process where they are included more in the regional planning of KH3000 (especially EAF) for the next 4 years, stating that the planning phase is not done participatory enough; Sigrun/WHG and Clemens/DKA are OK with how it is handled and do not support an extra feedback-loop on the regional inputs; they trust the process and that the planned activities reflect the need of the partner organizations; TV suggests a pragmatic approach: the ADA proposals will be submitted based on the inputs from the Regional Offices based on the partner's needs, feedback of the MOs will be included into the annual plans of KK describes shortly what was decided for the ToCs: Theories of Change are planned to support the programme interventions KH3000 and Senegal; the Programme Inteventions (EAF, CAM and MOZ) won't be supported by a ToC; Steps of the ToC for KH3000 taken so far: Project Team Meetingw with ProKos: Vision and Contribution to Change were reformulated, Stakeholder Mapping was presented; Outcome-Mapping for the 3 Results was produced: some open questions and some new activities were formulated (e.g. close/continuous support, learning action plans, power user, communication on news on platform)
