The main aspect of this framework programme is to verifiably improve the living conditions and strengthen rights of marginalized people in 10 countries in Africa and Central America.

RURAL DEVELOPMENT - NATURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

Food security, infrastructure and resilience are verifiably improved for marginalized people in 3 Central American and 6 African Countries.

Until the end of 2018, in the sector of Rural Development – Management of Natural Resources (**RD-MNR**), about 253.000 persons in 4 countries have sustainable access to water; about 27.500 persons in 2 countries benefit from improved hygiene conditions; about 450.000 persons in 5 countries benefit from actions on climate change; about 63.000 persons in 8 countries have increased food security, and about 73.000 persons in 8 countries have additional income.

HUMAN RIGHTS - CIVIL SOCIETY

The possibilities to exercise civic and human rights have verifiably increased for marginalized persons and CSOs in 3 Central American and 5 African countries.

Until the end of 2018, in the sector of Humans Rights – Civil Society (**HR-CS**), the partner organizations in 5 countries addressed 5109 cases of human rights violations (mainly against women and children, but also land rights and human rights in general) which, if necessary, were referred to the relevant authorities and further attended; in 6 countries, the organized civil society strengthened the policy dialogue with (local) authorities, what led to 24 concrete agreement with authorities.

KNOWLEDGE MANAGEMENT AND ORGANISATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

The partner organisations of HORIZONT3000 and its Member Organisation as well as other cooperation/ network partner improve their performance through services in the area of Knowledge Management and Organisational Development.

Until the end of 2018, a total of 162 organizations representing 1.074 persons, have gained new insights for their work via communities of practice, sharing events, specific trainings and exchange/learning visits; 6 Communities of Practice (3 in Central America, 2 in PNG and 1 in Senegal) have implemented joint learning and sharing activities; a concept for the KNOW-HOW3000 Internet Platform finalized in 2016 was applied, the restructuring and redesign has been completed. The Internet Platform was successfully adapted and redesigned, ensuring a better usability / user experience and functionality. Additionally

- ...the Internet Platform was accessed by 3.649 persons from partner countries and 3.059 from Austria (2016-2018). Files from the platform were downloaded 5.609 times (in 2017-18)

- ...22 TAs and Partner Organizations used the toolbox for Organisational Development. 245 tools and templates for 7 thematic areas of OD are available at the platform.

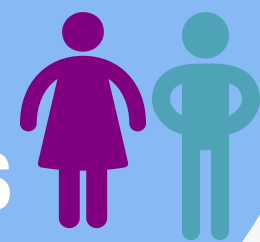

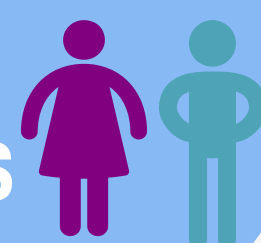

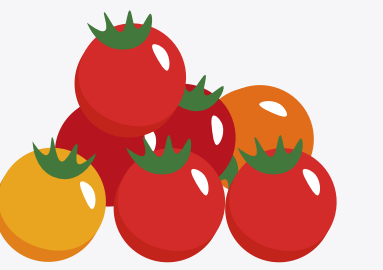

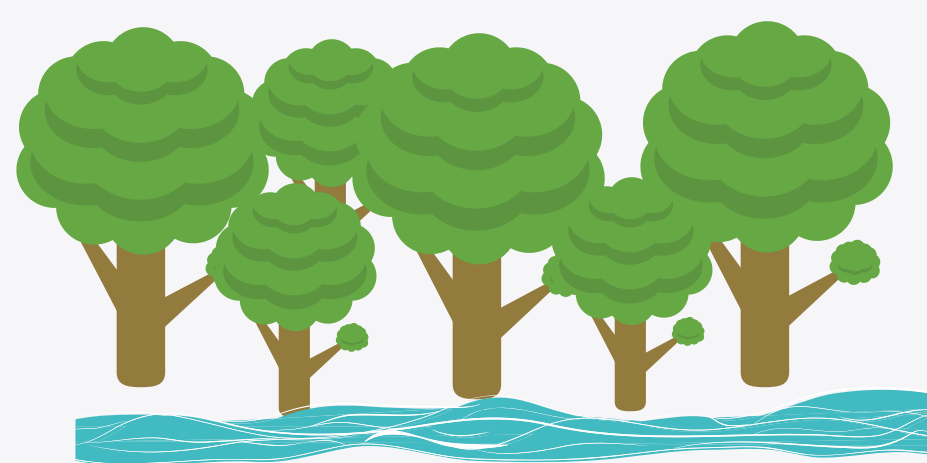

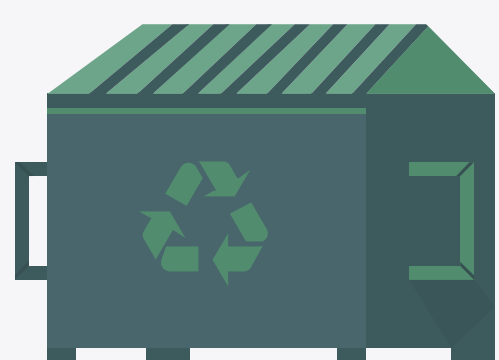

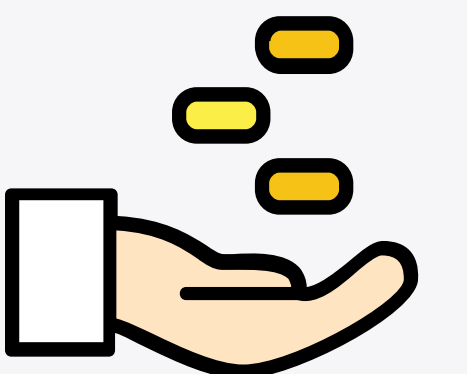

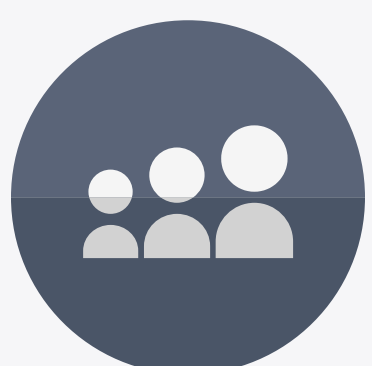
