## **RESULTS IN WORDS (PER END OF 2015)**

### **RURAL DEVELOPMENT - MANAGEMENT OF NATURAL RESSOURCES**

Until the end of 2015, in the sector RD-MNR, about 57.000 persons in 5 countries could get sustainable access to water for consumption or production, 130.000 persons in 4 countries benefit from improved sanitary facilities and/or improved hygiene standards and improved food security is ensured for about 185.000 persons in 7 countries. Further, about 5.900 Persons in 4 countries could diversify their income through financing instruments and about 23.000 farmers (and their families) in 8 countries have an additional and secured income through the (jointly) commercialization of their products.

About 682.000 tree seedlings have been planted via reforestation-measures or actions against soil erosion and an additional number of about 1216 ha were reforested (in 6 countries). In total, at least 120 communities elaborated 71 plans or agreements (in a participatory way) for environment protection or for actions for the use of natural resources benefitting 260.000 Persons in 4 countries.

#### HIMAN PIGHTS - CIVIL SOCIETY

Until the end of 2015, in the sector HR-CS, partner organizations have addressed 4048 cases of human rights violations referring them if necessary to the relevant authorities and further attended to the cases. 5368 actors and 102 organisations of the target groups or partner organisations have been linked to each other or to other actors. Target groups of the sector (i.e. disadvantaged rural communities, women, children/youth) are better represented in villages and organizations, in Guatemala and El Salvador by 98 persons, in Senegal representation increased on an average from 20% to 60%, and in Tanzania representation increased about 60%. Until the end of 2015, the available budget of authorities for addressing issues of the sector target groups has increased, in the two project regions in Uganda by 52% and 154% respectively (for child rights); in Nicaragua in one region the municipality for the first time budget for women's rights was allocated (3% of municipal budget).

#### **KNOWLEDGE MANAGEMENT**

1466 persons (451 in 2013, 661 in 2014 and 354 in 2015) have gained new knowledge/ insight in their field of work via 56 Specific trainings/ workshops (18 in 2013, 25 in 2014 and 13 in 2015) in 10 countries.

245 persons (119 in 2013, 95 in 2014 and 31 in 2015) have gained new knowledge/ insight in their field of work via 20 exchange visits (10 in 2013, 7 in 2014 and 3 in 2015) in 6 countries.

402 persons (2014: 232, 2015: 170) have gained new knowledge/ insight in their field of work via 13 sharing events (7 in 2014 and 6 in 2015) in 5 countries.




